General:

- 1. Ensure all hardware items have been included refer to assembly diagram.
- 2. It is recommended that the instructions are read through and completely understood before making any attempt to fit this product.
- 3. Be wary of any changes to vehicle designs or other accessories that may conflict with the installation of this product.
- 4. Before drilling ensure that the area is clear of fuel, electrical & other components.
- 5. All holes drilled into the body panels shall have all burrs & swarf removed then coated with a suitable rust preventative paint.
- 6. The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product were used to achieve the specified rating. If replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same rating & quality are used. Contact an authorised **Hayman Reese** dealer if further information is required.
- 7. Ensure that all hardware is fastened to torque list below check fasteners on regular basis.
- Towbar load rating sticker provided with this product shall be conspicuously located on inside rear end of the driver's door. (See diagram below).
- 9. Hayman Reese recommends that you check your tow ball to ensure that it complies with the Australian standards **AS 4177.2.**


Tow bar Maintenance and Care.

Hayman Reese recommends that bolt torque's, as listed below, are routinely and regularly inspected and checked for correct tension. Replace any worn or defective parts.

We recommended to remove Tow Ball Mounts (TBM's, tongues or lugs) when not being used for any considerable length of time.

So as to avoid injury, when not towing it is suggested that the tongue, Pull Pin and R-clip are removed then stored in a safe, clean and dry place, away from excessive moisture.

Hitch Pull Pins and spring "R" clips are regularly checked for proper installation. Replace any worn or defective parts.





- 1. Lower spare wheel
- Loosely secure RH side arm to chassis rail via 3 x M12 x 1.25P x 35mm bolts on underside of chassis rail, with 1 x tapped plate on wire inserted into chassis rail for forward most bolt.


Repeat for opposite side.



 Using two people, lift towbar up to side arms ensuring to sandwich red recovery side plate between side arms and cross tube, with 8mm spacer plate in recess of red plate.

Note: Red recovery side plates must have recess facing inwards.

Loosely secure towbar to side arms with 4 x M14 bolts per side complete with 1 x washers and 1 x nut per bolt.



- 4. Refer to sequence A, B, C, and D over page for final assembly instructions.
- 5. Tighten all bolts to the torques listed below:

M8: 22 N.m; M10: 48 N.m; M12I %&) D. '%) B'a / A % W %+) D: 140 N.m; M14: 155 N.m

IMPORTANT: Ensure all bolts are secured to correct torques using a calibrated torque wrench. Tighten side arms to chassis rail first in an even pattern/sequence. Repeat for centre section to side arms and finally torque all other fasteners.



- 9. From underneath the vehicle, locate and disconnect the RHS bumper 4-way connectors (1).
- 10. Patch the Trailer Harness mating 4-way connectors (2) in between the vehicle RHS tail light connectors (1).
- 11. Using a self tapping tech screw, secure the Trailer Harness ground ring terminal (3) to the vehicle chassis.
- 12. Mount the Trailer Socket (1) to the towbar mounting bracket using M4 fasteners (not supplied).
- 13. Route the Tail Harness (Tail Length: 1200mm)(2) along the towbar and towards the Trailer Harness 8-way connector.



- 14. Connect the tail harness 8-way connector (1) to the Trailer Harness mating 8-way connector (2).
- 15. Waterproof the back of the 8-way connectors (1&2) using electrical grease or silicone (3).

*Do not tow with your vehicle if the R CLIP or the SMART PIN NUT is loose or missing. Replacement parts are available from your Hayman Reese Distributor.






Fig 1. Smart Pin assembly

STEP 1

Insert Trailer Ball Mount (TBM) into towbar HITCHBOX, aligning hole in TBM SHANK with hole in HITCHBOX (Fig. 2).





STEP 2

Insert SMART PIN through hole in HITCHBOX and hole in TBM SHANK; ensure the LOCATORS are inserted into the NOTCHES in the HITCHBOX (Fig. 3).

STEP 3

Screw SMART PIN NUT onto SMART PIN; tighten SMART PIN NUT until finger tight, ensuring TBM is restrained from movement.

STEP 4




Fig 4. Tightening of Smart Pin Nut

Tighten SMART PIN NUT by turning nut a further 1/8th of a turn in the clockwise direction using a 24mm spanner (Fig 4).



Install SMART PIN R CLIP through the hole on the SMART PIN (Fig. 1).
